**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AMENDED FOR AGREED TEMPORARY ORDERS
2020-07 REGARDING ALL PARENTAGE CASES**


Pursuant to General Administrative Order 2020-02 entered on June 26, 2020 by Chief Judge Timothy C. Evans regarding COVID-19 Emergency Measures, Resumption of Operations:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that

1. On a temporary basis, Agreed Temporary Orders (i.e., orders that do not constitute a final and appealable judgement) may be submitted to the Court for entry via email transmission by either party with all counsel of record or parties (if not represented) included as a recipients of the email to both rmeadows3orders@cookcountycourt.com and ccc.d3parentage@cookcountyl.gov;
2. After review and approval by the Court, the Agreed Temporary Order shall be disseminated to all counsel of record by the Court. The Court may decline to enter any Agreed Temporary Order, but in so doing, shall timely communicate the reasons for the same. No Agreed Temporary Order shall be entered by the Court unless all counsel of record, or parties, if not represented by counsel, are included as recipients of the email containing the proposed Order.
 - a. All Agreed Temporary Orders shall bear the heading: **“AGREED TEMPORARY ORDER SUBMITTED BY ELECTRONIC MEANS;”**
 - b. All Agreed Temporary Orders shall, when feasible, bear the electronic signature of all counsel of record in the cause or the parties (if not represented by counsel);
 - c. All Agreed Temporary Orders shall contain the email address and contact telephone number of each counsel of record in the cause or the parties (if not represented by counsel);
 - d. All Agreed Temporary Orders approved by the Court shall be returned via electronic means to counsel of record or the parties (if not represented by counsel) until further process is established.
3. Any motions brought regarding the Agreed Temporary Order submitted by electronic means shall be presented and heard before the Parentage Judge whom the case is regularly assigned or a Judge sitting in his/her stead pursuant to established procedures and guidelines.
