**Procedure to submit Appoint Special Process Servers in Response to General

**EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

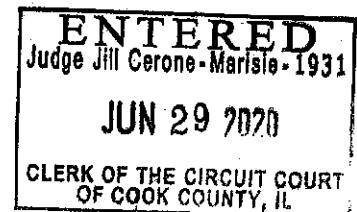
During this time until further Order of Court, Motions for Appointment of Special Process Servers  
will be granted if submitted electronically to **rmeadowsd3orders@cookcountycourt.com** so  
long as there is not an accompanying request for an Order of Protection. If there is an  
accompanying request for an Order of Protection, then the routine grant of an Order appointing a  
special process server will not take place.

Said motions will be reviewed and if so granted by the Judge and returned on Wednesdays or  
Thursdays.

If the Chief Judge of the Circuit Court of Cook County chooses to amend the terms of the General  
Administrative Order No. 2020-02, including but not limited to a period of time of suspension of  
Court operations, this Administrative Order is subject to change.
