- All Arbitrations are cancelled and will be rescheduled to a date in June, 2020. You will be notified by telephone.
- All Courthouse marriages are to be rescheduled
 - Contact retired Judge or church official to perform service
 - Contact Cook County Clerk – 847-818-2850/2851 if marriage license is due to expire.
- All Domestic Relations cases will be heard on an emergency basis ONLY at the Daley Center, 50 W. Washington Street, Chicago or call 312-603-6556.
- There is no Jury Duty for the next 30 days.
- ONLY CIVIL EMERGENCIES will be heard in Courtroom 205
 - There is a 30-day Moratorium on all Forcibles/Evictions and Foreclosures
 - All Civil Trials (Bench and Jury) will be rescheduled
