GENERAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 2016-02

SUBJECT: SPECIAL REPRESENTATIVES IN MORTGAGE FORECLOSURE CASES APPLICATION PROCESS, ATTORNEY'S FEES, AND REPORTING

General Administrative Order 2015-02 established a new procedure and guidelines for special representatives in mortgage foreclosure cases. This general administrative order covers the application process, attorney's fees, and clarifies the role of the special representative.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. General Administrative Order 2015-02 stands in its entirety, until further order of the court, and replaces all prior issued memoranda or procedures regarding special representatives.
- 2. Special representatives appointed by the court shall file a petition for reasonable attorney's fees and costs. Special representatives shall appear in court on the petition for a determination on the amount of fees and costs to be paid by the mortgagee requested in the petition. The petitioning for fees and costs shall be effective immediately.
- 3. Reports previously filed by special representatives, prior to General Administrative Order 2015-02, will not be filed. Special representatives should litigate the case as the attorney for the decedent. The elimination of reports and the role of the special representative shall be effective immediately.
- 4. In order for an attorney to be on a list for special representatives and be appointed by a judge, the following process will need to be completed:
 - (a) The minimum requirements to qualify as a special representative are set forth in the application attached with this General Administrative Order.
 - (b) The attorney seeking admission to the special representatives list shall complete the attached application by May 31, 2016.
 - (c) The application should be submitted to the Office of the Presiding Judge of the Chancery Division:

- (d) The applicant shall sit for an interview with a Special Representatives Committee, a committee to be determined by the Presiding Judge of the Chancery Division.
- (e) The Office of the Presiding Judge of the Chancery Division will notify successful applicants.
- (f) The applications will be accepted on an ongoing basis after May 31, 2016 with interviews scheduled as the committee deems appropriate.
- 5. Until the list of approved special representatives is established by the committee, appointments for special representatives should be based on the current appointment process using the appointment order template provided in General Administrative Order 2015-02.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR SPECIAL REPRESENTATIVE FOR DECEASED MORTGAGOR APPOINTMENT LIST

In order to be placed on the list of attorneys eligible to be appointed by the Court as a Special Representative in Cook County mortgage foreclosure cases, all applicants shall at a minimum meet the following requirements and obtain approval from the Office of the Presiding Judge of the Chancery Division.

- 1. Submit a completed application provided by the Office of the Presiding Judge of the Chancery Division. The application shall be completed under oath and notarized.
- 2. Be licensed to practice law in the state of Illinois.
- 3. Have a substantial amount of practice experience in the area of mortgage foreclosure for a minimum of five (5) of the last eight (8) years.
- 4. Possess significant in-court experience in mortgage foreclosure litigation or equivalent experience.
- 5. Submit to an inquiry regarding all areas of the applicant's past and current profession and/or employment, and have no serious disciplinary actions pending.
- 6. Be interviewed regarding qualifications by the Special Representative Screening Committee.
- 7. Attend and complete all required training programs and agree to attend Continuing Legal Education programs for the defense of mortgage foreclosure litigation.
- 8. Submit a current biography sheet in the format prepared by the Office of the Presiding Judge of the Chancery Division.
- 9. Agree to handle a reasonable number of matters representing mortgagors on a <u>pro bono</u> basis.
- 10. Submit to other background checks, if requested.
- 11. Have first or substantial second chair experience or equivalent experience in civil practice and civil trials.
- 12. An attorney on the approved list shall have and maintain appropriate errors and omissions insurance coverage and shall be required to present proof of said insurance, upon request, to the court.
