**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2020-8 (Amended July 31, 2020)**

**TOLLING ORDER - TAX DEED CASES - COVID-19 EMERGENCY**

Due to the COVID-19 crisis, the County Division of the Circuit Court of Cook County, Illinois has not conducted any hearings on Tax Deed Petitions since March 17 and will not do so until after August 22, 2020, consistent with the Amended General Administrative Order 2020-02 (amended July 29, 2020) issued by Chief Judge Timothy C. Evans. That amount of time totals 158 days.


Because the Court was and is unable to act during the above referenced time period, the court, pursuant to 35 ILCS 200/22-85, hereby orders that 158 days be excluded from the one-year period to take out and record a tax deed and/or obtain an order declaring a sale in error. No further order is required.

If a party needs additional time beyond the 158 days, that party shall file an appropriate motion seeking the additional time with sufficient notice to the State's Attorney's Office, and that motion shall be heard by the Calendar Judge to which it is assigned.

This Order shall be spread upon the records of this court this 31st day of July, 2020.
