**GENERAL ORDER: 03 D 9**

**SUBJECT: CHILD SUPPORT MOTIONS VIA TELEPHONE PILOT PROJECT**

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**


Commencing February 2, 2004, there shall be established a Pilot Project in the Suburban Districts 2-6 and the Expedited Child Support Division of the Circuit Court of Cook County enabling litigants and attorneys to set up routine motions filed in all domestic relations and parentage child support cases by telephone. The following routine motions requiring no fees shall be permitted to be noticed up by telephone to the clerk of the court in the applicable district:

- ◆ Appointment of a Special Process Server
- ◆ Leave to File Appearance or Otherwise Plead
- ◆ Leave to File Counter-Petition
- ◆ Motion to File Alias Summons
- ◆ Motion to Set Pre-Trial Date
- ◆ Motion for Release and Satisfaction of Judgment
- ◆ Leave to File Response to Petition
- ◆ Motions for Referrals for Conciliation
- ◆ Motion to Vacate DWP Order (Filed within 30 days)
- ◆ Motion to File an Amended Pleading and allow Parties to File a Responsive Pleading on a Specific Date

Every litigant or attorney setting up a routine child support motion by telephone shall be required to send written notice to opposing parties of record pursuant to local circuit court rules. The notice of motion shall be sent no later than ten (10) days prior to the date on which the motion shall be heard. The Clerk of the Circuit Court shall make available to all litigants and attorneys prototype samples of notices of motion and all motions covered in the Pilot Program.
