ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2020-DV-25 (Amended December 4, 2020)

**THIS ORDER PERTAINS TO COURTROOM 104 IN THE MAYWOOD
COURTHOUSE, DISTRICT 4.**

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

The Clerk of the Circuit Court of Cook County shall continue all Civil and Criminal Cases for a 21-day period.

All cases set for status, motion presentment, hearing, trial or returns of emergency orders of protection on the following dates shall be continued by the Clerk of the Court to 9a.m. automatically as follows:

Cases set for December 11, 2020 shall be continued to December 31, 2020 for status;
Cases set for December 14, 2020 shall be continued to January 4, 2021 for status;
Cases set for December 21, 2020 shall be continued to January 11, 2021 for status;
Cases set for December 22, 2020 shall be continued to January 12, 2021 for status;
Cases set for December 23, 2020 shall be continued to January 13, 2021 for status;
Cases set for December 24, 2020 shall be continued to January 14, 2021 for status.


Any protective orders and plenary orders of protection that are set to expire on the dates mentioned above will be extended until the next court date as provided above. All extensions of protective orders, plenary orders of protection, and emergency orders of protection shall be transmitted by the Circuit Clerk to the Sheriff's for entry into the LEADS system.

The Clerk of the Court shall send post-card notices to all litigants of the above continued dates immediately.

All emergency orders of protection filed on December 11, 14, 21, 22, 23, and 24 shall be filed and heard at 555 W. Harrison St., Domestic Violence Courthouse, Chicago, Illinois.
