ORDER


This matter coming to be heard on the Court’s own motion, and the Court having been fully advised in the premises, the Court hereby states:

Motion Section Judges are being presented with a large number of motions challenging the constitutionality of the six person jury provided for in 735 ILCS 5/2-1105. In the case of *Ramirez v. Neurological Surgery, et al.*, 15 L 7110, Judge William Gomolinski has issued a briefing schedule on a motion challenging the constitutionality of the six person jury statute. Therefore, in the interests of justice and judicial economy, one judge is designated to hear these motions on a consolidated basis.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. All pending and subsequently filed motions challenging the constitutionality of the six person jury provided for in 735 ILCS 5/2-1105, are hereby consolidated.
2. This order applies to all such motions filed after June 1, 2015, whether currently pending or previously denied without prejudice.
3. Judge William Gomolinski is designated to hear the consolidated motions, and has set a general status for all pending motions to stay on October 7, 2015, at 11:00 a.m. in Room 2205.
4. All cases shall remain before their assigned Judges for all other issues.
