**REASSIGNMENT OF CASES FROM MOTION CALENDARS A, B, AND F TO MOTION
CALENDARS E, X, AND TO JUDGE MARAS (ASSIGNMENT SECTION)**

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: Effective July 17, 2017


1. Judge Flanagan (Motion Calendar E), Judge Gomolinski (Motion Calendar X), and Judge Maras (Assignment Section) have volunteered to receive additional cases.
2. Judge Gillespie (Motion Calendar B), Judge Johnson (Motion Calendar F), and Judge O'Hara (Motion Calendar A) have volunteered to surrender cases.
3. Approximately one hundred and seventy (170) cases per Calendar will be removed from Motion Calendars A, B, and F, and reassigned to Motion Calendars E and X, and also to Judge Maras in the Assignment Section.
4. The reassignment will be done in a random fashion.
5. After the effective date of this Order, any pending court date on a case chosen for reassignment set before Judge Gillespie, Judge Johnson, or Judge O'Hara shall be stricken.
6. All parties of record on cases chosen for reassignment will be given electronic or postcard notice that shall indicate the case has been chosen for reassignment. The notice will indicate the Judge and Calendar the case has been reassigned to, and will provide a new court date before the newly assigned Judge and Calendar.
7. All provisions of Law Division General Administrative Order 16-2 will apply to all cases selected for reassignment.
8. Trial dates in Courtroom 2005 and Trial Setting dates in Courtroom 2006 **shall remain** for any case selected for reassignment.
9. All motions to continue trial on any case selected for reassignment must be presented before the Presiding Judge of the Law Division pursuant to Law Division General Administrative Order 16-2 Section VI. B.

10. Nothing in this Order will limit the inherent power and discretion of any Judge to enter an order the Judge feels is appropriate.

It is further ordered that this Order be spread upon the records of this Court.
