GENERAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

In light of Cook County Cir. Ct. G.A.O. 2020-01 (amended May 1, 2020),

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. All Emergency and Interim Orders of Protection currently scheduled to return or expire on May 18, 2020, through and including May 29, 2020, are hereby extended, rescheduled and continued as follows:

Cases returning May 18, 2020 are hereby extended and continued to June 16, 2020.
Cases returning May 19, 2020 are hereby extended and continued to June 17, 2020.
Cases returning May 20, 2020 are hereby extended and continued to June 18, 2020.
Cases returning May 21, 2020 are hereby extended and continued to June 19, 2020.
Cases returning May 22, 2020 are hereby extended and continued to June 22, 2020.
Cases returning May 26, 2020 are hereby extended and continued to June 23, 2020.
Cases returning May 27, 2020 are hereby extended and continued to June 24, 2020.
Cases returning May 28, 2020 are hereby extended and continued to June 25, 2020.
Cases returning May 29, 2020 are hereby extended and continued to June 26, 2020.

2. The prior General Administrative Order (G.A.O. 2020 P 03) regarding the extension of these Orders of Protection is still in effect for the dates outlined therein. The dates that those cases were extended to is further extended as referenced above;

3. Nothing in this section shall be interpreted to limit the discretion of a judge to further reschedule an Emergency or Interim Order of Protection;

4. All such cases shall be returnable at the currently scheduled return time on the rescheduled return date;

5. The circuit clerk shall docket the above continuances in the official records of the cases affected and transmit the information necessary for entry in the LEADS system to the sheriff for that purpose;

6. This Order shall apply to all Emergency and Interim Orders of Protection returnable or set for the Probate Division at the Daley Center, 50 W. Washington, Chicago, Illinois; and

7. This Order shall be published in the Chicago Daily Law Bulletin and at www.cookcountycourts.org/ProbateDivision to inform litigants and attorneys about these procedures.
