GENERAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 2009 - 04

**SUBJECT: INITIAL CASE MANAGEMENT CONFERENCES FOR
MORTGAGE FORECLOSURE CASES, CLERK OF THE COURT'S
RESPONSIBILITIES**

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 218, an Initial Case Management Conference shall be held in all civil cases within 35 days after the parties are at issue and in no event more than 182 days following the filing of the Complaint. It has been determined that the appropriate time for the scheduling of such Initial Case Management Conference in mortgage foreclosure cases is approximately 60 days after the filing of the Complaint.

IT IS, HEREBY, ORDERED AS FOLLOWED:


1. Effective July 1, 2009, the Clerk of the Court shall assign to each mortgage foreclosure case filed in the Chancery Division an Initial Case Management Conference date approximately ~~60~~ days after filing. The Initial Case Management Conference dates shall be set on the days and at the times of the default foreclosure calls for each calendar, unless otherwise designated by the Presiding Judge.
2. The Clerk of the Court is not required to mail postcard notices of the Initial Case Management Conference Dates.
