SUBJECT: Procedure for Rescheduling Cases Involving the Cook County State's Attorney's Office in Response to General Administrative Order No. 2020-01

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

Notwithstanding General Administrative Order No. 2020-01, all Domestic Relations cases to which the Cook County State's Attorney's Office is a party are to be continued not to the 30th day General Administrative Order No. 2020-01 would require precisely, but rather to the closest day that the Cook County State's Attorneys Office had already planned to be present before each particular judge, but in no event before April 16, 2020.


For example, a case assigned to a judge who only hears State's Attorney cases on Mondays that was originally scheduled for Monday, March 23rd and would be returning per General Administrative Order No. 2020-01 on Wednesday April 22nd shall hereby be set instead for Monday April 20th, as this is the closest State day before that judge to the day General Administrative Order No. 2020-01 would have required.

If the Chief Judge of the Circuit Court of Cook County chooses to amend the terms of General Administrative Order No. 2020-01, including but not limited to the period of time of reduction of court operations, this General Order is subject to change.
