## **ORDER**

This matter coming to be heard on the Court's own motion, and the court having been fully advised in the premises, the court hereby states:

On March 11, 2013, Ullico Casually Company, a Delaware property and casualty insurance company, was placed into receivership for purposes of rehabilitation. A "Rehabilitation and Injunction Order" was entered by the Delaware Court, which enjoins all persons or entities from instituting or further prosecuting all actions, pre-trial conferences, trials, etc., involving any person or entity insured by Ullico Casualty Company, for a period of 180 days.

It is anticipated there will be many motions filed in the Law Division and First Municipal District, asking that the cases involving parties insured by Ullico Casualty Company be stayed and/or transferred to the Insurance Calendar. It is in the interests of justice and judicial economy will be best served by the designation of one judge to hear these motions on a consolidated basis.

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. All pending and subsequently filed motions seeking a stay of proceedings and transfer of the case to the insurance calendar involving parties insured by Ullico Casualty Company are hereby consolidated.
- 2. This order applies to all such motions filed prior to the date of the consolidated hearing.
- 3. Judge Kathy M. Flanagan is designated to hear the consolidated motions, and has set a general status for all pending motions to stay on April 2, 2013, at 11:30 a.m. in room 2210.
